By making a gift to us in your Will, you can enjoy your assets in your lifetime and still provide a contribution to Sydney Philharmonia in the future. We do advise you consult your solicitor.

There are several options for you when making a Bequest and the list below are the most common forms:

You may choose to nominate a **specific sum of money**, which will be paid to Sydney Philharmonia before the rest of your estate is divided. The advantage of this type of 'specific bequest' is its certainty and simplicity.

A gift of a **nominated percentage** of the remainder of your estate (known as a 'residuary bequest') has the advantage of being certain and simple as well having the added benefit of being flexible enough to allow changes in the composition of your assets or your financial situation.

Gifts **of specific assets** are also very welcome. These depend on your continuing to own the asset until the gift takes effect and may require special wording. It would be helpful to discuss this with us before proceeding.

#### **Sample Wording for a Bequest of a specific sum of money**

I give to Sydney Philharmonia Limited ACN 001 253 256 (known as Sydney Philharmonia Choirs) of Pier 4, Hickson Road, Millers Point, for its general purposes, the sum of \$..... For which the receipt of the Secretary or other authorised Officer shall be an absolute discharge.
